Fees

Agistment rates	\$6.60	per day for dry mares
	\$6.60	per day for wet mares and mares in foal.
	\$8.80	per day for weanlings (includes supplementary feeding)
	\$8.80	per day for hand fed/race condition mares
	\$9.90	per day for yearlings (includes supplementary feeding)
Worming	\$25	per mare
Strangles & Tetanus	\$30	per mare, per vaccination on arrival.
Foaling	\$250	mares will be foaled under supervision at Warwick Stud. This fee covers the cost night watch personnel and foaling alarms.
Weaning Fee	\$250	The weaning of your foal includes being weaned from its mother, boxed for several days, and being taught to lead and tie up.
Breeding fee (Off Farm Stallions)	\$550	A working fee will be charged for mares breeding to off farm stallions via transported semen.

Terms & Conditions

Warwick Stud is the name under which Jack Primmer & Co Pty Ltd ACN 001931737 trades as a horse stud. All contracts regarding Warwick Stud are with Jack Primmer & Co Pty Ltd as proprietor.

Live foal arrangement is based on the fee being paid when the mare leaves the stud or within 30 days of the final 42 day test whichever is earlier. If the mare slips or has a dead foal then she may take a free return as per Victorian Breeders & Stud Masters Assn terms of service.

A copy of the mare's registration papers must be forwarded to the stud for brand verification before she can be served.

Mares will be wormed and vaccinated for strangles and tetanus upon arrival at Warwick Stud at the owner's expense.

The owner covenants and agrees with the studmaster and the proprietor and acknowledges that neither the owner or any person claiming under or through the owner shall have any claim against the studmaster or the proprietor for or on account of or in respect of any loss or damage which the owner may suffer by reason of the death or injury to the mare and or foal of the mare whether caused by or a result of accident, illness, misadventure or otherwise.

The studmaster and proprietor shall not be responsible to or liable to the owner for any loss or injury which may occur through the escape of the mare or foal from any field, paddock or stable.

The owner indemnifies the proprietor against all costs, claims, expenses, damages and proceedings arising out of or in any way connected with the behaviour of the mare and or any foal.

Routine or emergency treatment may be requested at the discretion of the stud with costs charged to the owner/s of the horse. Warwick stud will make every attempt to contact the owner where possible before major surgical or costly procedures are commenced. However Warwick Stud or its veterinarian reserves the right to undertake any action/treatment believed to be in the best interest of the horse.

Neither Warwick stud or the owners of the stallion make any representation regarding the stallions fertility, including but not limited to its ability to breed or its ability to cause a mare to be impregnated.

Warwick stud accepts no responsibility for any defects that have occurred after the semen has left the farm.

These terms and conditions should be read carefully. Acceptance of these terms and conditions is deemed given upon arrival of a mare at Warwick Stud or the shipment of transported semen to a mare.
